

Freeze-protected rechargeable water extinguisher W 6 SKF-1 W 9 SKF-1

Description

The W 6 SKF-1 and W 9 SKF-1 freeze-protected rechargeable water extinguishers have internal propellent bottles. Once armed, these extinguishers are activated by actuating the push button.

The fully pressure-tested steel containers are only subjected to pressure when actually in operation. The gas propellent is carbon dioxide.

The jet of spray can be directed and dispensed accurately at the heart of the fire using the hose and nozzle.

The suppressant is a mixed solution of NEUFROL C-30, which can be used across a temperature range of -30°C and +60°C.

Wall brackets are included. Protective boxes and other accompanying items of equipment (e.g. nomenclature panels) are available in various variants.
